Annual Report Showcases the College's Achievements for 2020-2021

Luther College has released its Annual Report for the 2020-2021 school year. The Annual Report highlights many successes, despite the pandemic, from both the High School and University campuses. In addition, the Annual Report publicly releases the College's audited financial statements for the fiscal year. The full report is <u>available here</u>.

Significant achievements and activities included:

- The University campus operated entirely remotely, both in teaching, research, and administrative operations
- The High School campus operated in-person, except for an eight-week period of remote learning due to province-wide COVID cases and subsequent restrictions
- The Rev. Dr. Marc Jerry was installed at the eighth President of Luther College
- Financial expenses were much lower than usual due to the pandemic which cancelled in-person extra-curricular activities at the High School and in-person teaching at the University
- 1.77 million dollars was raised from both high school and university fundraising initiatives

Looking to the future, Dr. Jerry says, "There is much to be hopeful for, as our work continues as an educational ministry that produces graduates who will be an important part of the healing of the world to come."

As well, Luther College is formally announcing the 2021-2022 Luther College Board of Regents including new Board Chair, Gregory Swanson following the 2021 Annual General Meeting held on Saturday, October 16, 2021.
